The middle school staff and students were treated



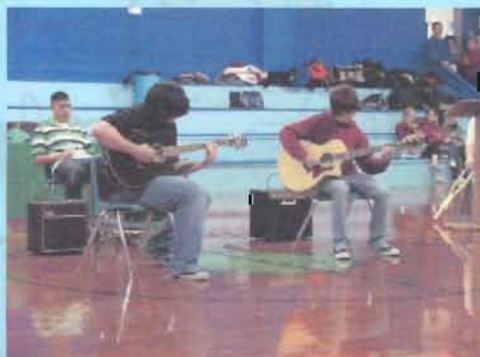
to a special Christmas program on Thursday morning, December 21.
